SUBMITTING A GREAT GLOBAL GRANT APPLICATION

GRANTS MUST FIT WITHIN ONE OF THE SEVEN AREAS OF FOCUS OF THE ROTARY FOUNDATION

- Peacebuilding and Conflict Prevention
- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Water Sanitation and Hygiene
- Supporting the Environment
Basic Education and Literacy
- Community Economic Development
- Maternal and Child Health

GLOBAL GRANT ELIGIBILITY

- Large and long-lasting project.
- Community needs assessment.
- Within 7 Areas of Focus
- Sustainable and Impactful with Measurable Goals
- Clubs to be qualified:
 - Any one member from the club to have attended an GMS.
 - Signed Club MOU with District
 - All reporting of previous projects has been completed.
 - Not more than ten Global Grant Projects under progress
- No Conflict of Interest
- Project cost: Min USD \$30,000
- World Matching Fund: USD \$0-400,000
- Foreign Contribution: 15% of (DDF + Cash) Contributions
- No Application Deadline: for Humanitarian and VTT projects
- For Scholarships its 30th June.
- Restrictions as per Rotary Grants Terms & Conditions

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES: WITHIN ROTARY'S AREAS OF FOCUS

- Humanitarian projects that provide sustainable, measurable outcomes that address real community needs.
- Vocational training that improves job skills in a community through educational programs & teams of professionals who travel abroad to teach or gain knowledge/skills.
- Scholarships that fund international graduate-level study by people seeking a career within an Area of Focus.

GETTING STARTED

- Use your district's local expertise.
- Conduct a Community Assessment.
- Set project goals.
- Work with partners.
- Create a project plan and budget.

FINDING RESOURCES

- Publicise your project plan.
- Participate in project fairs.
- Secure funding outside Rotary.
- Secure funding through Rotary.

IMPLEMENTING YOUR PROJECT

- Communicate and seek feedback.
- Raise awareness about your work.
- Ask questions along the way.

EVALUATING AND SHARING

- Measure your results.
- Promote your project and share what you have learned.
- Submit reports.
